Precautions for safe handling

Technical measures:

Take measures to prevent the build up of electrostatic charge. Use explosion-proof equipment. Wash hands and face thoroughly after handling.
Use a closed system if possible. Use a ventilation, local exhaust if vapour or aerosol will be generated.
